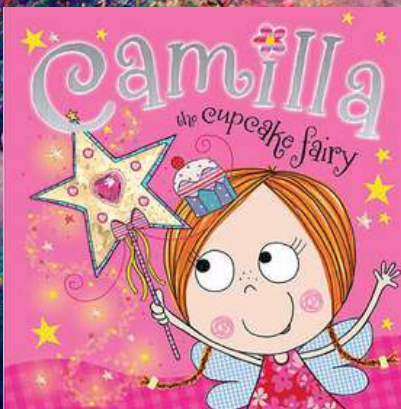
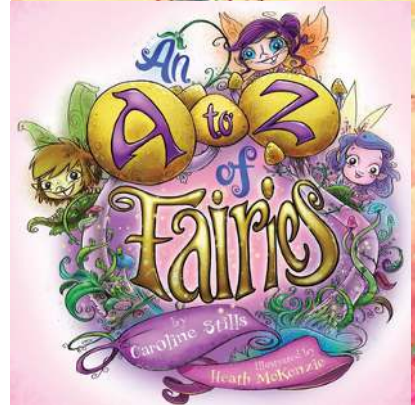


THAT'S WHAT DRAGONS DO by Raymond McGrath

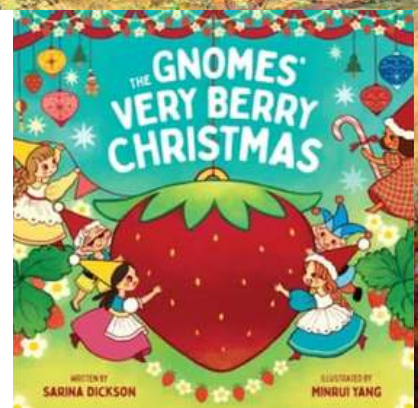


CAMILLA THE CUPCAKE FAIRY by Tim Bugbird

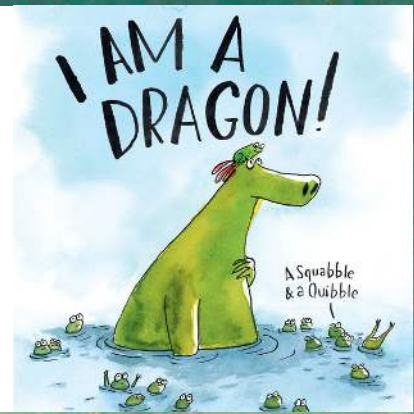
THE GNOMES' VERY BERRY CHRISTMAS by Sarina Dickson

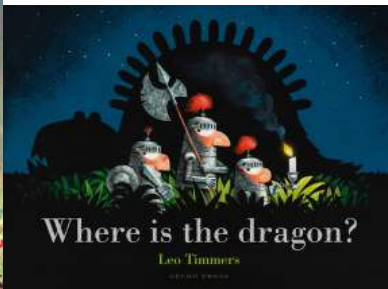
I AM A DRAGON! by Sabina Hahn

In the middle of the night, three knights go in search of a dragon. But in the dark nothing is what it seems!



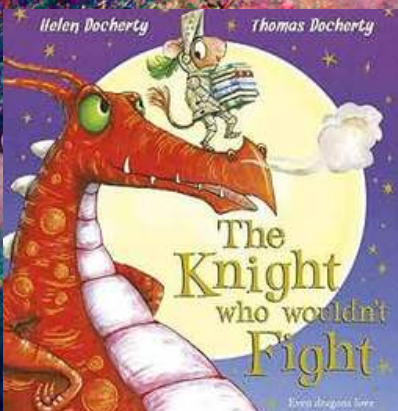
ONCE UPON A DRAGON'S FIRE by Beatrice Blue

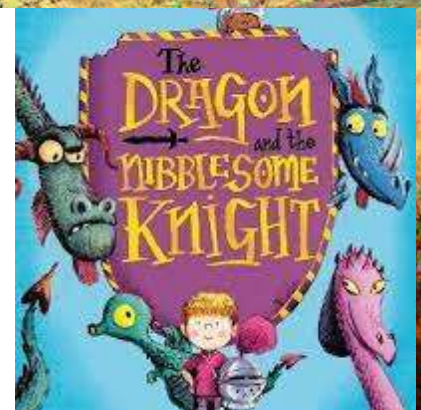
THE KNIGHT WHO WOULDN'T FIGHT by Helen Docherty

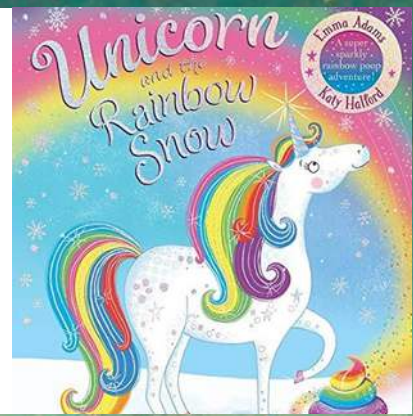
THE DRAGON AND THE NIBBLESOME KNIGHT by Elli Woollard

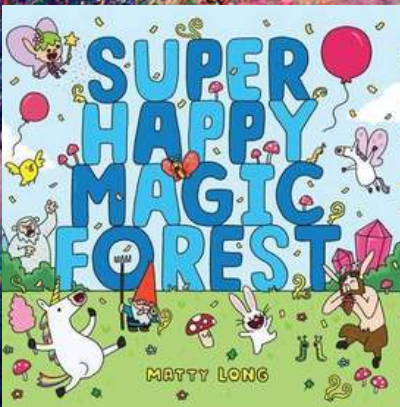
THE ENCHANTED FOREST by Chrissy Metge
